## Inauguration of the Library at Chernobyl Echo Foundation in Chişinău

The National Campaign for the collection and donation of the book for people with special needs was launched within the framework of the **Project:** "Library Network Support Services: modernising libraries in Armenia, Moldova and Belarus through library staff development and reforming libraries [LNSS]" (2015 – 2018) of the Program ERASMUS +ERASMUS+ Capacity Building in the Field of Higher education (CBNE) and Library National Awareness Week Program. Library of Chernobyl's Echo Foundation was opened, the initiative being scheduled for April 26th, 2017. The Chernobyl's Echo Foundation commemorates the 31st anniversary of the Chernobyl nuclear disaster by rehabilitation and social integration of children, young people hit by the consequences of the Chernobyl accident.
